Health care workers can unknowingly come in contact with a person with active TB; therefore, it is important that you have a TB test once a year. All health care workers must be tested. If you have ever had a positive reaction to a TB skin test, if you have been treated with TB medication or are pregnant or breast-feeding, you need to alert your health care provider before a TB skin test is done to have alternative TB testing methods. See below for further descriptions:

- If you have tested positive or been exposed to TB in the past, you will need to submit a copy of the results of your most recent normal chest x-ray and a TB physical completed within the past 12-months. You will then need to submit an updated TB Physical annually.
- If you are pregnant or nursing, you will also need to have a TB physical to be in compliance until you are eligible to receive an updated TB Test.

Although it is very rare, it is possible for the skin test to be false negative (you have TB infection, but the skin test is negative) or false positive (you are not infected with TB, but the skin test is positive). Additional skin test can be done to rule out false negative results.

Since early treatment for TB is critical, contact your health care provider for confidential TB skin testing. Confidential TB skin testing is also available through your local health department. Anyone testing positive with active TB needs to notify his or her regional manager immediately.

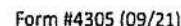
