HISTORY & Urgent Care Course

In summary Marvin W Hodges is a 83 yr old male with the PMH of paroxysmal atrial fibrillation on Pradaxa, hypertension, hyperlipidemia, HFpEF EF 50-55%, valve regurgitation, obstructive sleep apnea not on CPAP, mild pulmonary hypertension, CKD stage IIIB, osteoarthritis with moderate fall risk presented to the AUC with mechanical fall with leg swelling.

Patient reports he was standing up from the commode when he lost his balance and fell backwards and bumped his head. He denies loss of consciousness. He denies chest pain, palpitations preceding the fall. He denies headache at this time. He denies numbness, tingling. He states he has had 5 falls in the past week. He describes it as his left knee giving out. He also notes he has had increased bilateral lower extremity swelling associated with leg heaviness. He denies chest pain, shortness of breath, orthopnea. His wife suggested him to come to the emergency room. He states he has been compliant with Lasix.

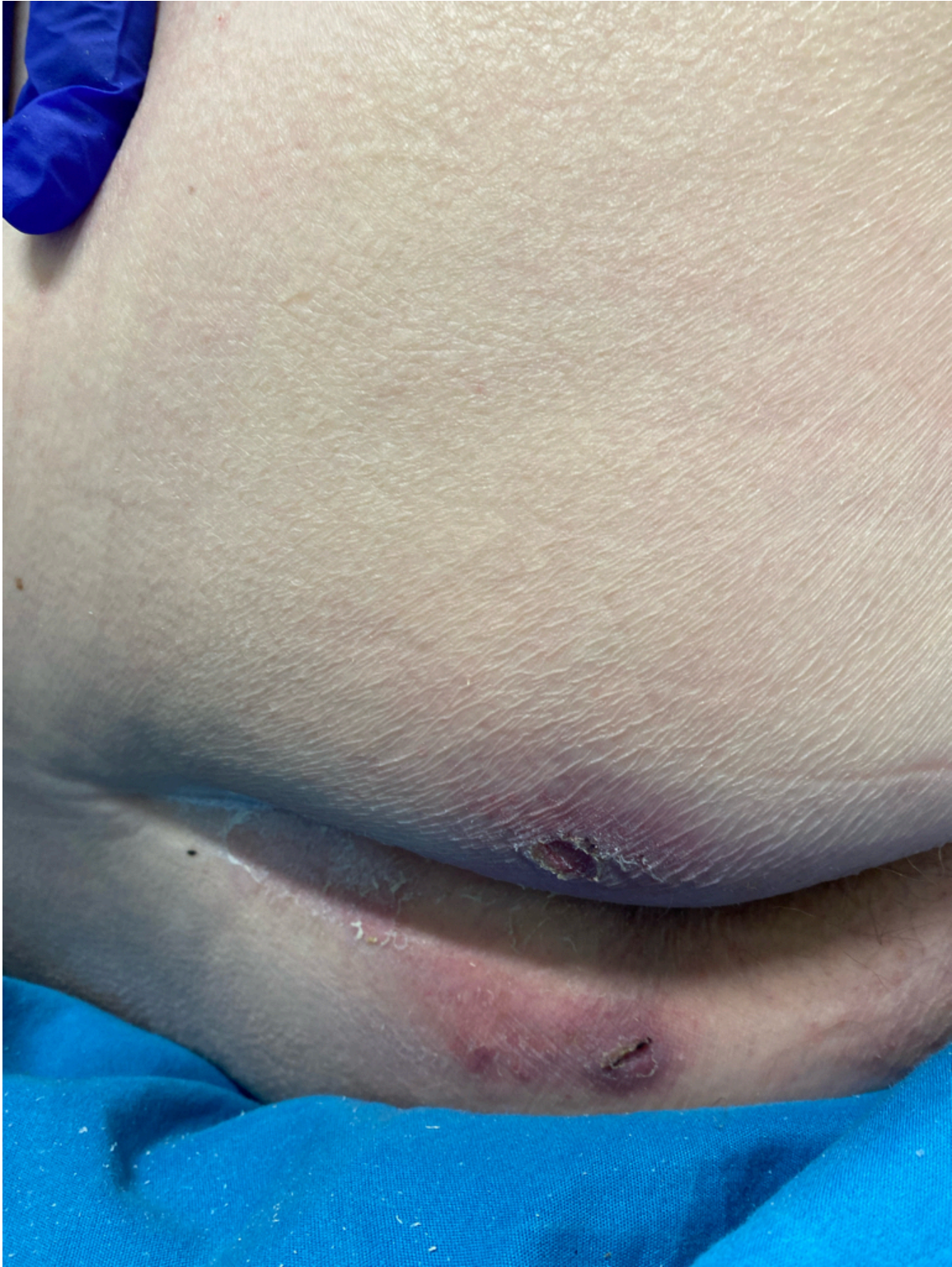

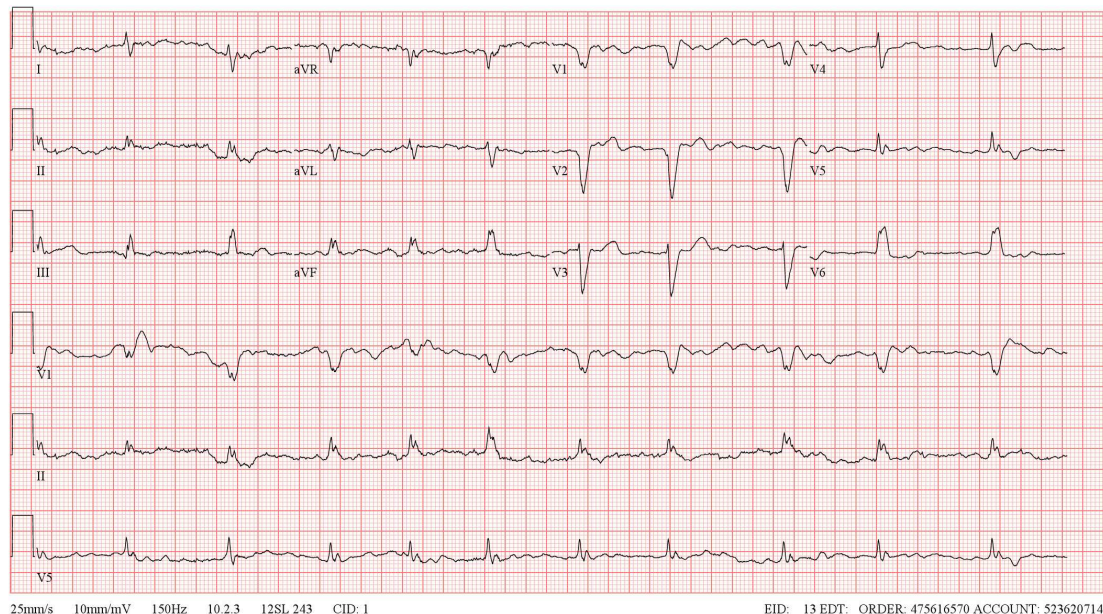

1. Cleanse/irrigate wound with 0.9% Normal Saline.
2. Apply foam dressing over wound if needed for mild drainage. Apply a calcium alginate for wound with moderate to heavy drainage.
3. Reinforce with additional gauze or a foam dressing as needed.
4. Instruct patient to change every 3-7 days and as needed for maceration, dislodgement, or rolled edges.
5. Instruct patient to keep scheduled follow up appointment for wound care.
