Homebound status: Due to diagnosis of Orthostatic hypotension, the patient is experiencing decreased endurance and mobility, increasing the likelihood of falls. To safely leave their home, the patient needs assistance from another person and an assistive mobility device.						
Clinical Condition Requiring Homecare: <p class="MsoNoSpacing">The patient is a 75-year-old male with a medical history of hypertension, hyperlipidemia, and type 2 diabetes mellitus. He was recently hospitalized due to a syncopal episode and was found to have orthostatic hypotension. He lives in a multilevel townhome with his daughter, son-in-law, and grandchildren. The daughter works during the day, while the son-in-law is available at home during the daytime. The home has bathroom access on both levels, with the patient's bedroom located on the second floor. He is alert and oriented 4. Mobility-wise, the patient ambulates independently indoors without an assistive device and uses a single-point cane with distant supervision for outdoor surfaces. He requires supervision when negotiating curbs but performs transfers and sit-to-stands independently.</o:p></o:p></p> <p class="MsoNoSpacing">The Timed Up and Go (TUG) test was completed in 10 seconds, indicating a low fall risk. Minor right-sided weakness was noted in shoulder abduction/flexion, grip strength, and hip flexion. A home exercise program (HEP) was reviewed with the patient, focusing on seated therapeutic exercises, sit-to-stands, and ambulation. The patient was educated on mobility options, including transportation resources, and the primary care provider (PCP) was notified regarding a referral for outpatient physical therapy and mobility transit application.
